# PREPARING FOR YOUR VISIT

#### WHAT TO BRING:

- → Insurance Card (if applicable)
- → State ID Card or Driver's License
- → Medication Lists
- → Relevant Past Medical Records
- → Proof of income (if applying for financial assistance)
- → Last filed income tax (if applying for financial assistance)
- → Proof of Residency (only for Substance Use evaluations)

## WHAT TO EXPECT UPON ARRIVAL:

- Check-in at reception and complete paperwork.
- Meet with a Patient Navigator.
- Meet with a Clinician as available.

Once the intake assessment is complete, you may be referred for the appropriate services. The SDA process can take up to two hours, or more, depending on your needs.

### **HELPFUL TIPS**

- Arrive prior to 2:00 p.m. to be seen that day for an intake assessment.
   It is common for the process to take several hours.
- Due to other scheduled services, you may not be called back in the order that you arrive.
- You may bring a member of your support system with you to the intake.
- Minors must be accompanied by a legal guardian.
- Only one adult and/or child will be seen for an intake at a time.
- interpreter services are available if needed.
- We accept most insurance and offer a sliding fee scale for individuals with limited financial resources.
