What is OSS?

The Out of School Support (OSS) program supports students that are facing multi-day or long-term school suspensions.

When is OSS provided?

Monday-Friday from 8:00-3:00 P.M.

How does OSS work?

1. The student's case manager or school will contact the OSS Coordinator.
2. The case manager will assist with getting the student's course work to the staff assisting in OSS.
3. On the first day of OSS, parents will need to meet with the student's therapist at 8:00 A.M. to get the OSS services added to their treatment plan.

What else should I know?

- Lunch and breaks are provided
- Parents are responsible for transportation, but assistance can be provided at times.
- Staff will assist with assigned course work and supervise participating students.
- For older students and extended suspensions, they may partake in community service and have the occasional field trip/reward day.
- **Participating students must be CCMHC clients.**
