What is OSS?

The Out of School Support (OSS) program supports students that are facing multi-day or long-term school suspensions.

When is OSS provided?

Monday-Friday from 8:00-3:00 P.M.

How does OSS work?

- 1. The student's case manager or school will contact the OSS Coordinator.
- The case manager will assist with getting the student's course work to the staff assisting in OSS.
- 3.On the first day of OSS, parents will need to meet with the student's therapist at 8:00 A.M. to get the OSS services added to their treatment plan.

What else should I know?

- Lunch and breaks are provided
- Parents are responsible for transportation, but assistance can be provided at times.
- Staff will assist with assigned course work and supervise participating students.
- For older students and extended suspensions, they may partake in community service and have the occasional field trip/reward day.
- Participating students must be CCMHC clients.
