Substance Use Disorder Treatment

Crawford County Mental Health Center provides residential and outpatient services for substance use disorder (SUD). Our residential facilities offer Intermediate Treatment, Social Detox, and Reintegration statewide. After leaving residential care, clients can access Intensive Outpatient and Outpatient services, in person or by telehealth. We believe that treatment and recovery occur in a non-linear fashion. Thus, an individual may enter services at any level. Assessments and referrals for all levels of care are conducted through Same Day Access.

Same Day Access:

Same Day Access offers readily available mental health intakes, screenings, and referrals for new patients. **No appointment needed. Walk-ins are welcome!**

Treatment Options

Social Detox

A short-term program providing supervision, observation, and support for individuals undergoing substance withdrawal. It ensures safe treatment of withdrawal symptoms and facilitates a smooth transition to the next suitable treatment, often intermediate care.

Outpatient Therapy

Focuses on facilitating changes in clients' substance use behaviors. It addresses lifestyle, attitudinal, and behavioral issues that could hinder treatment goals. Outpatient treatment includes individual therapy, group therapy, and/or family counseling.

Intermediate Treatment - ATC

Provides structured services at the [Addiction Treatment Center](#), a 24-hour residential facility. Clients receive structured support, counseling, educational classes, and community resources to equip them with foundational tools for post-recovery.

Intensive Outpatient Therapy

Intensive Outpatient treatment provides education and counseling services while allowing the client to apply their newly acquired skills outside of treatment. This can be provided any time during the day or week. Program can include overnight housing.

Women's Renewal House

A 24-hour residential facility that provides support to women and their children who are recovering from substance use. Clients benefit from structure, counseling, and classes to equip them with foundational tools to begin recovery post completion.
